Blue Cards & Child Safety

Keeping our children safe is of great importance to us and it is a requirement of SLSA and SLSQ that all patrolling members 18 years or over, and volunteers working in an official role with children, must hold a current Blue Card - Qld's 'Working with children' check.

Members must also complete some mandatory online training to accompany their Blue Card.

- Child Safe Awareness (CSA)
- Child & Youth Risk Management Strategies (CYRMS)

Skills Maintenance (proficiency)

All Bronze Medallion, SRC, IRB, Observer and Age Manager award holders must complete an annual skills maintenance session before 31 Dec 2023 to remain proficient in their award and remain eligible to train, assist, patrol our beach or compete.

Skills Maintenance dates are:

- Sat 9 Sep 2023
- Sun 8 Oct 2023
- Sat 19 Nov 2023
- Sun 3 Dec 2023

If you plan on attending a Skills Maintenance session and haven't renewed your membership, please do so before enrolling in the applicable course through your Members Portal eLearning area.

- Strategic planning for our club's future

- Grant funds used for the following purchases: new Kawasaki SSV, old office renovation, Search & Rescue kit, marquees for Nippers, first aid equipment and training equipment.
- Patrol Trailer scope and design underway (partially funded by a grant)
- Emergency fix of issue in male showers.
- Security system to be installed for gym access (in September or asap).
- 23/24 budget finalised.
- Membership renewals underway.
- Setup of Square payments system for Nipper BBQs, fundraising and online shop.
- Various other tasks and projeccts in preparation for start of Nipper and Patrol season.
- Workshops with SLSQ to understand changes being implemented across programs and how these will impact/assist members.
