



EDUCATION REPORT

It has been a season of challenge and change. The change of administration procedures early in the season proved to be challenging in terms of training and assessing students. With this in mind I am extremely grateful for your patience and grateful for the efforts of the administration staff to ensure our members, future members and community were supported and front of mind.



Our volunteers are essential for the success in the day to day operation of our Palm Beach Surf Life Saving Club. Without you it wouldn't be possible to provide the service to the community. With over 50 newly qualified Bronze and SRC members this season I can only imagine how many preventative drownings, and injuries will take place because of this. We start this process young as well. Our nippers can enjoy the education, challenge and culture of thriving in healthy activities within a controlled, safe environment. This concept of learn through play is not just for the young ones. Adult training and learning experiences take place each week, and it is fantastic for our community to see in action.

A youth development camp took place over the school holidays at Tallebudgera Rec Centre, where our young people learnt through over 70 different scenario based activities, in and out of the water. Trained actors were employed to randomly fall victim to injury and illness throughout the week, so it would not be uncommon for a person to collapse or choke in the middle of the dining hall. Such a valuable experience for these young people, while obtaining qualifications and certification such as Advanced resuscitation and IRB crew.



The willingness to support, learn and challenge ourselves, is in abundance. We have the foundation for some seriously life-changing experiences for our members, all while making us better equipped to guide and support the community as well as look after our environment. I look forward to the engagement Palm Beach Surf Club has with its new and existing members, leaders, learners, and teams.

In the new season I would like to challenge our existing members to two things.

1) Invite a friend to become a member. This is a simple and achievable step to ensuring we increase our numbers. Although we are all good at giving our time, we are also very busy in our lives. YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Surf Lifesaving Youth Development Camp

The Lifesaving Development Program is an education program that allows members to gain a number of lifesaving awards in a short space of time. Program participants will gain a number of awards including First Aid, Advanced Resuscitation Techniques and IRB Crewperson OR Silver Medallion IRB Driver. Participants will also be exposed to additional skills and development opportunities including pathways, teamwork, leadership and lifesaving operations. The Lifesaving Development Program training method uses the Experiential Learning Theory (ELT) education model. ELT uses scenario-based training to give candidates the opportunity to experience realistic emergency scenes to practice their lifesaving skills. Scenarios are designed and conducted under the guidance of specially trained facilitators and safety officers. While evaluations of the past programs highlight the value of scenario-based training for development of candidate skills, some participants may feel some emotional stress participating in such realistic training.

GRANTS REPORT

Our Club continued to have a successful season seeking out grants to upgrade lifesaving vehicles and accessories, provide equipment for our Nippers and Surf Sports programs and to generally maintain our clubhouse to a high standard.

Grant success last season enabled the purchase of the following items in 2023/24:

• A new patrol trailer, Kawasaki 6-seater SSV and an IRB motor for our lifesavers.

- Upgrades to our club facilities to increase storage for training and education delivery equipment.
- Funds to upskill two volunteer members as pool lifeguards to support our sports training delivery.
- A Search & Rescue kit for Nippers and Patrol use.
- Marquees for Nippers and carnivals.
- A more robust BBQ to serve our hungry Nippers each Saturday.
- Patrol uniforms to outfit our new recruits and provide replacements for current serving lifesavers.

Successful grant applications submitted this season which will benefit members and our community in 2024/25 include:

- Tugun Community Bank: funding approved to purchase IRB safety kit including 6 x personal flotation devices (PFD's) and a store of club-owned wetsuits.
- Beach Safety Equipment Fund (Surf Life Saving Australia): an IRB motor replacement, another 6 x PFDs, first aid equipment and devices including pulse oximeters, bleeding control kits, first aid equipment storage bags and a compact suction unit.
- Federal Government Volunteers Grant: \$1649 towards tablets for our Nipper sign on.
- Queensland Government: \$7,500 to support programs and purchases to encourage more women and girls in sport.
- SLSQ funding of \$32,500 for Club Facilities Maintenance.

Further grant applications have been submitted with outcomes to be determined later in the year. These include an upgrade of our club dormitory; replacement of office technology; equipment and training to support volunteers; and education and surf sport programs to encourage more women and girls into the club. With thanks to our club volunteers Anna Carroll and Leesa Monaghan for submitting the very detailed 'Play Our Way' application! 



Ken Bagnall (20/01/1934 -20/03/2024) 90yrs Young

Dad would have been so happy having his celebration of life at Palm Beach surf club as he told me many times, he wished to have his ashes spread out to sea in front of his favourite place. The surf club was a place that held a lifetime of wonderful memories.

Ken joined the surf club in the season 1950/51 with his mate Gil Graham both gaining their Bronze that season. In this era Dad would tell me that they'd often hitch hike down to the club from Brisbane until the time came that Gil got himself a motorbike with Ken as the designated pillion passenger. In the 50s Ken represented the club with great success and won consecutive State beach flags championships in 56/57 and 57/58 seasons. In 1956 himself and Maurie Webb were honoured with being the Olympic Torch Bearers for the Gold Coast legs of the 1956 Games held in Melbourne.

Many older members would recall events that no longer exist including pillow fights and the chariot race. Ken loved participating in these and as you walk up the stairs of the surf club you can see Ken as the jockey with his great mate Guru Luka leading the charge in the chariot race!

After some years away during the mid-70s Dad took active roles within the nippers working with good friend and club stalwart, Andy Frizzell. Ken always offered himself to coach at club level with great success. 3.1 Only financial Active, Reserve Active, Long Service, Honorary Life Members and officers shall be eligible to vote at Council Meetings and shall be entitled to one vote each and the case of an equality of votes the Chairperson shall have a second or casting vote, provided that no members shall be entitled to vote at any General meeting if his annual subscription is in arrears at the date of the meeting.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

1.1 Officers shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting by secret ballot (if necessary).

1.2 Nominations, which shall be in writing, shall be lodged with Secretary at least fourteen (14) days before the Annual General Meeting at which the election is to take place.

1.3 A list of the candidates' names in alphabetical order will be posted in a conspicuous place in the office or usual place of meeting of the Association for at least seven (7) days preceding the Annual General Meeting.

1.4 Should at the commencement of such meeting, there be insufficient number of candidates nominated, nominations may be taken from the floor of the meeting.

1.5 Voting shall be by show of hands or a division of Ordinary Members, unless not less than one-fifth of the Ordinary Members present demand a ballot, in which event there shall be a secret ballot. The Chairman shall appoint two members to conduct the secret ballot in such a manner as he shall determine and the result of the ballot as declared by the Chairman shall be deemed to be the resolution of the meeting at which the ballot was demanded.
